



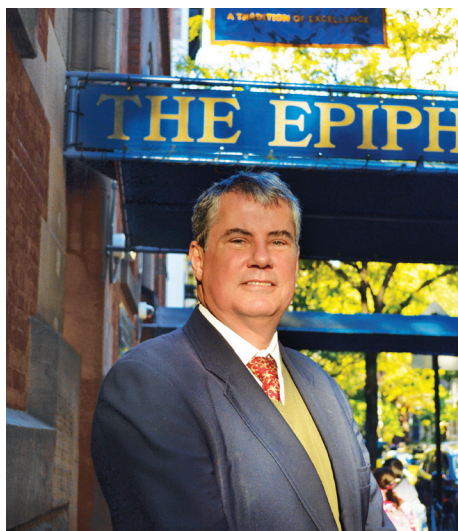
**The Epiphany School Foundation** | **Annual Review 2016-2017**

Thank you for your support in making Epiphany one of New York City's top Catholic Schools. Established in 1999, The Epiphany School Foundation was created to enrich the educational experience of every Epiphany student. Through your kindness and generosity, our mission remains strong while keeping our tuition at an affordable level.

Your gifts enhance the academic programs at Epiphany, creating a unique, diverse and spiritual learning environment that enables our students to reach their full potential.



Through annual giving and special events, we raise approximately one million dollars each year for the enrichment of technology in our classrooms including the use of iPads, laptops and RealTouch Interactive LCD Displays. We also provide funding for enhanced language, wellness, science, art, and music programs, tuition assistance for current students, as well as funding for teacher assistants in the Lower School and supplemental funding for professional development. I extend my sincere gratitude to our donors for making this possible.

I am proud to report that 82% of current families contributed to the Annual Fund during the 2016-2017 school year, funding our many educational programs and services that are not covered by tuition. This year, that amounts to over \$1,500 per student. It is of great importance that we reach our Annual Fund goals so that The Foundation can continue to offer Epiphany children what they need to excel in the classroom. Please consider making a gift to The Annual Fund this year, which closes on June 30, 2018. All gifts to The Annual Fund are fully tax-deductible and are eligible to be matched by corporations.

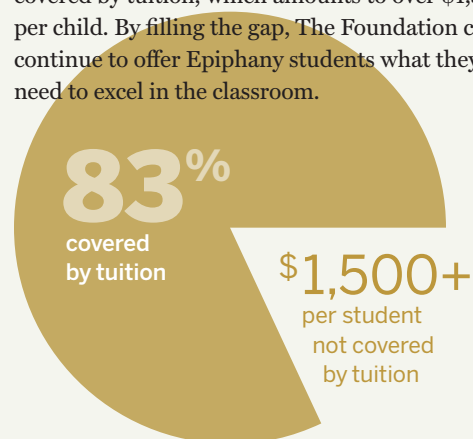

# 5 Reasons Why It's Essential to Give

Support for The Foundation fuels the mission of the school: to provide an educational environment that inspires academic achievement, fosters spiritual growth, and celebrates the individual.

## 1 Fill the Gap

The Annual Fund provides funding for many programs and services that benefit students and are not covered by tuition. Only 83% of the cost of educating each Epiphany student every year is covered by tuition, which amounts to over \$1,500 per child. By filling the gap, The Foundation can continue to offer Epiphany students what they need to excel in the classroom.

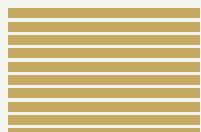


## 2 The Epiphany Value

## 3 Enhance Programs

Your support enables The Foundation to enhance our educational programs in the areas of technology, foreign language, science, wellness, music and art. We also provide funding for teacher assistants in the Lower School, supplemental funding for staff professional development, and tuition assistance for faculty pursuing advanced degrees.



## 4 Digital Readiness

RealTouch Interactive LCD Displays in every classroom are just the beginning of digital readiness at Epiphany. We offer a full 1:1 iPad program for all students in grades 2-8, a 1:2 iPad program in Kindergarten and First grades and iPad Centers in Nursery and Pre-Kindergarten. Students have access to 60 MacBooks and 30 Chromebooks in our Upper School Computer Lab and Lower School students have access to 30 Chromebooks. Through online learning programs such as IXL and Reading A-Z, teachers are able to assign and monitor unique programs that best meet each student's needs.



## 5 Provide Opportunity

Gifts to The Foundation make it possible for us to establish endowed funds that provide long-term support. Our funding allows us to offer financial aid to both new and current families in need. The unique academic programming and intimate school community at Epiphany attracts a diverse student population, proudly representing over 40 different zip codes from New York and New Jersey.

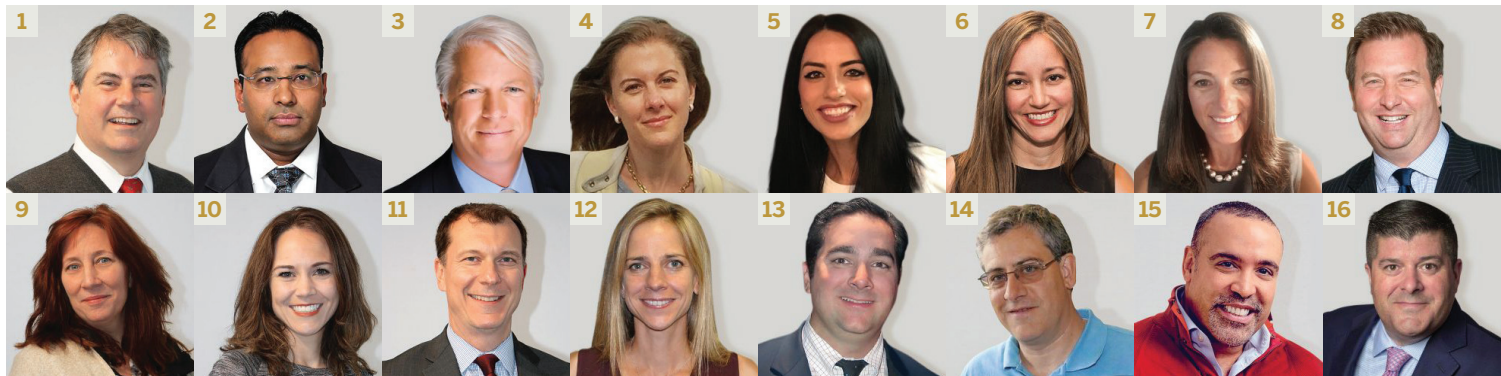
### 23rd Annual Golf Outing / MAY 15, 2017

## Wellness In The Schools

Programs for the well being of Epiphany students beyond the classroom.

The Epiphany School first welcomed **WELLNESS IN THE SCHOOLS (WITS)**, a national non-profit organization that teaches kids healthy habits to learn and live better, by implementing their Cook for Kids program in 2016. Our culinary trained WITS chef, Gisselle Madariaga, works with our students and staff daily to transform our cafeteria menu while providing nutrition education.

Students also enjoy the benefits of WITS labs, nutritional culinary education classes, which celebrate seasonal recipes and ingredients.

Throughout the year, WITS offers Café Days, where local chef partners interact with students and prepare meals during lunch. Through these special visits, our community had the unique opportunity to meet celebrity chefs, Rocco DiSpirito and Bill Telepan, and have also had the experience to learn from Chefs Elliott Prag and Olivia Roszkowski of the Natural Gourmet Institute.



With the success of **COOK FOR KIDS**, Epiphany initiated WITS' **COACH FOR KIDS** program in 2017, which enables children to reach the recommended 60 minutes of activity during the school day. Our WITS Coach, Sarah Merck, reinvents recess, trains school staff and provides fitness education. In the spring, students and their families will be invited to participate in a Family Fitness Fun Night, which offers athletic classes and activities for all ages and skill levels.

After working with our WITS chef and coaches, students return to class after lunch and recess ready to focus and learn, and develop healthy habits that will last a lifetime. The continued success of the Wellness In The Schools program is ensured by the Epiphany Wellness Committee, a parent volunteer committee that promotes good health at school throughout the year, currently led by Epiphany parent, Felicia Tanoff.
