Director of Development, June 2018–present



Walk & Fall Festival / OCTOBER 15, 2017

At the 8th annual Walk event, families and friends joined together as teams to fundraise and walk down the East River Promenade before returning to the lively Fall Festival at our 22nd Street Campus. Again, the Foundation partnered with NY Catholic Charities to execute the Feeding Our Neighbors Food Drive, providing nearly 10,000 meals to those in need. Walk and Fall Festival Chairs, Eileen Pino and Alex Vaina, worked together on this special community tradition, which raised over **\$75,000***.



Hall of Fame Reception / NOVEMBER 4, 2017

Over 200 guests came together at The Yale Club for the 5th annual Hall of Fame Induction and Cocktail Reception. Hall of Fame Inductees included Richard Capuano '71, Ray Curley and Claire Rennell, and we bestowed the first Joe Falzon Spirit of Volunteerism Award to Helen and Peggy O'Dea. Alumnus speaker, Joe Malewich '71, closed the evening with his heartfelt words about the importance of sponsoring the Epiphany education. The event, chaired by Regan Murphy '99, raised over **\$39,000***.



Christmas Car Raffle / DECEMBER 14, 2017

A total of 802 Mercedes-Benz Car Raffle tickets were sold for the drawing held during The Epiphany School Foundation Christmas party. The success of the Car Raffle is largely attributed to Epiphany parents and the Foundation Board of Trustees. Board members accounted for 45% of sales, selling a total of 368 tickets. The Foundation extends sincere thanks and gratitude to Joe Castle, for selling 101 tickets in 2017, helping us raise a total of **\$44,000***.



Spring Auction Benefit / MARCH 21, 2018

More than 300 guests joined us for our greatest fundraiser of the year, Epiphany's annual Spring Auction. Thanks to the generosity of our parents and friends, 225 items were donated and over 1,400 bids were placed. Donations for the 2018 Special Appeal, facility improvements, totaled over \$70,000. Co-chairs Jennifer Dowd and Jennifer Turetsky worked with Foundation staff and over 50 volunteers to make the evening a great success, raising over **\$169,000***.



Golf Outing / MAY 14, 2018

The 24th annual Epiphany Golf Outing is the school's longest running fundraiser. Over 85 golfers came out to the Scarsdale Golf Club in Hartsdale, NY to support The Epiphany School Foundation. 
