

Bridging the Gap

The Epiphany School Foundation is a separate nonprofit organization that provides funding to The Epiphany School for numerous programs and services that benefit its students. Only 83% of the cost per student is covered by tuition, leaving a gap of approximately \$1,500 for each student. The Foundation works to bridge this gap by raising money to support four key initiatives and keep tuition as low as possible for everyone.



Enhanced Programming

By supporting the Foundation you enable our faculty to deliver more innovative, well rounded, problem solving oriented, cross-curricular programming throughout the School utilizing partnerships with programs such as Project Lead the Way, CodeSpeak Labs, NYC Kids Project, Rising City Arts and the New York Historical Society.

Cutting-Edge Technology

Support from the Foundation allows for continued upgrades and improvements in technology integration throughout the School. iPad technology is introduced to students in our Early Childhood Center and expands to a 1:1 iPad program in Kindergarten through Grade 8. Investments in keyboards for Grades 7 and 8, RealTouch Interactive LCD Displays in every classroom and online learning platforms ensure that the use of technology makes learning more efficient and effective.

Tuition Assistance

Faculty Support

Faculty support funding from the Foundation allows for investment in faculty and staff that are dedicated to enhancing the educational experience of our students. This includes Assistant Teachers in Toddler Twos through Grade 4, a reading specialist, math

> coordinator and specialized faculty in art, music, foreign language, and physical education. In addition, we are able to provide teachers with professional development opportunities, continuing education assistance and Christmas bonuses.



Annual Fund / YEAR LONG

The Annual Fund is the primary fundraising vehicle for the Foundation, kicking off with an annual appeal on #GivingTuesday. The Annual Fund provides unrestricted funding for programs and services essential to helping The Epiphany School meet its goal of educating the whole child amongst a diverse community. Thanks to the support of past parents, friends, alumni and 74% of our current families, the Annual Fund raised \$311,499.

Car Raffle / December 13, 2018


