Thank you for your support, because of your generosity and fortitude The Epiphany School continues its tradition of excellence.

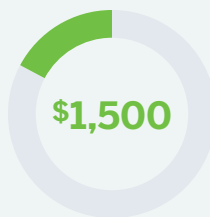
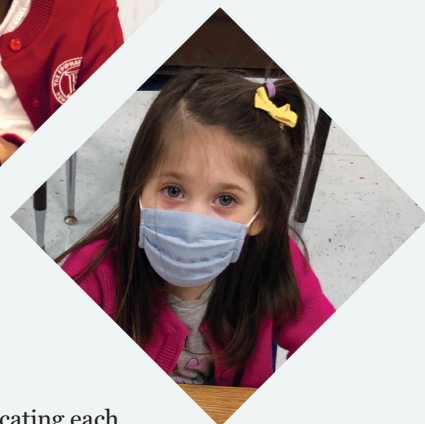

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, we thank you for your support of The Epiphany School Foundation. While this year has been challenging, the Foundation has found ways to adapt and enhance the education of our students and support our faculty in new ways. Without the generosity of our parents, past and present, alumni and friends, we would not be able to accomplish all that we have.

The Foundation strives to keep tuition affordable for all families, attracting and maintaining a diverse student population. Only 83% of the cost per student is covered by tuition and the Foundation helps close that gap. Inside the classroom, the Foundation adapted to the technological needs caused by COVID-19 by providing additional laptops and interactive digital whiteboards, expanding the iPad program from 2:1 to 1:1, and providing the Swivl camera to all our classrooms. This enhanced technology allowed students to feel as though they were a part of the classroom while learning from home.

Epiphany's tradition of excellence stems from our dedicated educators, who ensure our students' success. The Foundation provides funding for continuing education and professional development for our faculty. In addition, we also provide assistant teachers to Toddler Twos through Grade 4, a reading specialist, math coordinator, and specialized faculty in art, music, foreign language, and physical education.

To ensure the continued success of our students, please consider making a contribution to our Annual Fund. The Annual Fund provides funding for our educational programs and services that are not covered by tuition. We strive to have 100% of current families participate. All gifts to the Annual Fund are fully tax-deductible and eligible for company matching.

In addition to the Annual Fund, you can contribute to the Foundation through our events. Although we were not able to gather in person this past year, our donors were unwavering during the pandemic, by showing their support virtually for our events. These events help raise money for our School while enhancing the connection among our supporters. We encourage everyone in our community to attend as many events as possible and get involved as an event volunteer. All are welcome!

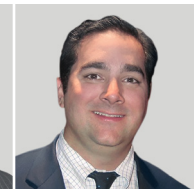

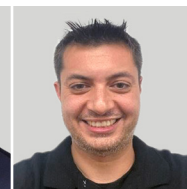

1 Annual Fund / JULY 1, 2020 – JUNE 30, 2021

The Annual Fund is the primary fundraising vehicle for the Foundation, kicking off with #GivingTuesday on December 1, 2020. The Annual Fund provides unrestricted funding for programs and services essential to helping The Epiphany School meet its goal of educating the whole child amongst a diverse community. Thanks to the support of past parents, friends, alumni and 80% of our current families, the Annual Fund raised \$320,065.

2 The Walk / OCTOBER 24-25, 2020

The 11th Annual Walk was held virtually for the first time ever. Hundreds of families walked in spirit together to support Epiphany from afar. Partnering with NY Catholic Charities, we provided hundreds of meals through the Feeding Our Neighbors Food Drive. Walk Chair, May Gaffney worked to make this event as successful as possible, raising a net of \$64,794.

3 Virtual Spring Benefit / MARCH 18, 2021

Our biggest fundraiser of the year included both silent and live auctions, a premier raffle, a live appeal, a special message from our School's leadership, a video of our students and speeches from this year's Hall of Fame inductee, Monica Murphy and the Joe Falzon Spirit of Volunteerism awardees, Jerry Mullaney and Marty Regan. 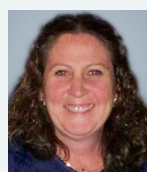

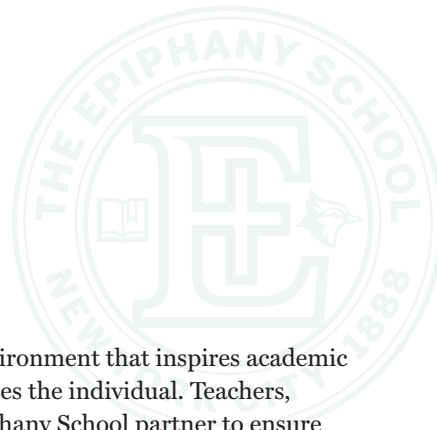
