

The Epiphany School's educational excellence is evident across all grades.

Fill the Gap


New York State Test Results for The Epiphany School have continually risen from 2014 to 2022, even with changing curriculum standards, technology advancements, and the disruption of the pandemic.




MAP Growth Testing

Epiphany Class of 2022 NWEA National Average



Fundraising Initiatives

1 Annual Fund / JULY 1, 2021-JUNE 30, 2022

The Annual Fund is the primary fundraising vehicle for the Foundation, kicking off with #GivingTuesday on November 30, 2021. The Annual Fund provides unrestricted funding for programs and services essential to helping The Epiphany School meet its goal of educating the whole child amongst a diverse community. 
4 Golf Outing / MAY 16, 2022









The Epiphany School
