Percentage of Students Demonstrating Proficiency




New York State Test Results for The Epiphany School have continually risen from 2014 to 2022, even with changing curriculum standards, technology advancements, and the disruption of the pandemic.


MAP Growth Testing

1 Annual Fund / JULY 1, 2021-JUNE 30, 2022

The Annual Fund is the primary fundraising vehicle for the Foundation, kicking off with #GivingTuesday on November 30, 2021. The Annual Fund provides unrestricted funding for programs and services essential to helping The Epiphany School meet its goal of educating the whole child amongst a diverse community. Thanks to the support of past parents, friends, alumni and 75% of our current families, the Annual Fund raised \$244,903.

2 The Walk / OCTOBER 30-31, 2021

Hundreds of families walked in spirit together to support The 12th Annual Walk for Epiphany. Partnering with NY Catholic Charities, we provided hundreds of meals through the Feeding Our Neighbors Food Drive. Walk Chair, May Gaffney worked to make this event as successful as possible, raising a net of \$82,115.

Our biggest fundraiser of the year made its triumphant return in person at Guastavino's and included both silent and live auctions, a golden ticket raffle, and a live appeal. 
Golf Outing / MAY 16, 2022
